Libraries for sustainability. Ecological transition laboratory

• General description (300 words)

Public libraries have regularly supported environmental awareness activities to promote environmental preservation and contribute to a more just and sustainable

society. Examples of these initiatives include seed banks, lectures, workshops, visits, urban garden management, environmental education projects, and specialised documentary collections.

The environmental impact of a library is influenced by factors such as energy efficiency and the building's location (easy access on foot, by bicycle or public transport). In addition, there are many opportunities to improve sustainability in internal management, such as efficient use of water and energy, waste management, green purchasing and the creation of green spaces. It is also important to reconsider the management of the documentary collection (eliminating plastics, minor repairs, donations) and to adapt services for users with more sustainable tools, such as e-books and recycled paper.

Drawing inspiration from a project at the Médiathèque de la Canopée la Fontaine in Paris, the Library Services Management Office launched the Ecological Transition Laboratory. This project involved the active participation of professionals from 19 member libraries of the XBM. Under the guidance of a team of experts from Espai TReS · Territory and Social Responsibility, the participants contributed their knowledge and perspectives to the Laboratory, thereby fostering a collaborative learning community.

Developed throughout 2023, the project has culminated in the publication of a document entitled *Libraries for sustainability: How to transform your library into an agent of eco-social change* This resource provides a valuable tool for libraries looking to address new challenges and incorporate sustainability values into their practices.

Activities and tasks

The project, designed by the Library Services Management Office with support from Espai Tres, was presented to all libraries of the XBM to introduce the workshop and offer them the opportunity to participate.

Once the registration process was completed a learning community was established, consisting of 19 library staff members and two technical experts in environmental management issues.

This working group met in person on four occasions throughout 2023. The meetings were designed to promote reflection on the relationship between libraries and sustainability. Between sessions, the libraries conducted independent work to experiment and organised virtual meetings for group tasks, supported and guided by the technical team from Espai TReS.

The document *How to transform your library into an agent of eco-social change. Ecological Transition Laboratory* is the outcome of the project "Laboratori de Transició Ecològica a les Biblioteques" (Ecological Transition Laboratory in Libraries). It describes key concepts related to sustainability in libraries, proposing practical recommendations and specific tools for libraries that seek to embrace sustainability as an integral part of their mission and activities.

The document is structured logically, beginning with a reflection on the relationship between libraries and sustainability, emphasising the vital role of libraries as key agents in promoting sustainable practices.

It then looks at sustainability in the specific context of a library, exploring areas where actions can be taken to improve this aspect. It highlights the essential role of the various stakeholders involved in this initiative.

Finally, the document presents a set of ten guiding principles for libraries to achieve sustainability, followed by a section detailing practical steps for moving forward in this direction.

To assess and improve sustainability, a checklist is also provided for use by library staff. The document contains two appendices at the end: one with the bibliography and reference documents used in the drafting of the document, and one with specific proposals for Library Service Management Office regarding sustainability.
